## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

SDHR Degree and PG College students are accountable for

- ⊙ Recognize and abide by this code and any modifications made to it.
- ⊙ Show respect for the authorities, staff, seniors, and fellow students by acting in a respectful and polite manner.
- ⊙ Utilize the institution's educational resources and facilities to your fullest potential in order to advance your academic career and your scientific knowledge.
- ⊙ At all times, act reasonably and with dignity while upholding the nation's laws and human rights.

## STUDENT CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR ON CAMPUS

- By 9.00 a.m., students must be seated in class. The grace period is limited to five minutes. The campus will not be open to students after 9:30 a.m. The session must start on time, and students are not allowed to arrive late or leave early.
- In the course of the day, students shouldn't leave campus (between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.). Only in extraordinary cases, and with the prior approval of the principal and the head of the relevant department, may students be allowed to leave the campus. Only after receiving the principal's approval will a gate permit is granted.
- Students are required to dress appropriately for class. It is not acceptable to wear sandals, jeans, or T-shirts. A valid ID card must be carried at all times.
- Mobile phone use is absolutely forbidden in all academic settings, including lecture halls, labs, workshops, libraries, computer labs, offices, and seminars.
- On campus, all interpersonal communication must be conducted in English.
- The CR is to get in touch with the HOD for an appropriate replacement if a teacher is absent for whatever reason.
- Without a letter of authorization, students are not permitted in the hallways or anyplace else outside of the classrooms or labs. It is possible to use free time at the sports lounge, library, and bookstore.
- All academic and extracurricular activities, including seminars, workshops, clubs, sports, College Day, and national festivals, are encouraged so that students can use them to hone their technical and soft skills.
- In order to become responsible professionals for the nation, students are expected to have decent manners, discipline, and honesty.

- On or off campus, students should not participate in ragging in any way.

### **STUDENT GUIDELINES**

- + It is suggested and required of students to
- + Attend all scheduled events on time.
- + Attend lectures, workshops, labs, and other events on a regular basis.
- + acknowledge their instructors and
- + Without using vulgar words or rude gestures, people should communicate effectively.
- + Don't endanger others' safety by bringing real or fake weapons to college or the dorm.
- + Steer clear of informal conversation and rumour-mongering.
- + Don't sit on things like parapets, staircases, or footpaths.
- + While on campus, wear an identity card.
- + Avoid using or possessing anything that is strictly forbidden, such as chewing gum, narcotics, tobacco, alcohol, or other intoxicating substances.
- + There is no tolerance for anti-institutional, anti-social, anti-national, anti-communal, indecent, immoral, or political behaviour on campus or in the dorms.
- + Do not plan, attend, or take part in any agitation or activity that is supported by a political or religious organisation.
- + Do not participate in any strike, parade, or agitation, including screaming slogans or engaging in a boycott of
- + Permission from the principal is required in advance for any educational, recreational, or industrial visits.
- + Avoid driving your own vehicle to the college. It's against the law to drive carelessly or recklessly, use your horn, or have more than one passenger on your motorcycle.
- + Report any unauthorised external entry onto campus or into the dorms as soon as possible.
